

Action Points

Call2PedalAction 26th October 2018

General

Participants write to their local county councillor voicing their support for the motion of 6th November, plus a request that they sign up for Space for Cycling

Organise study visits to Waltham Forest with key politicians, officers, and community leaders.

Residential streets

- Check Neighbourhood Plans to establish whether there is scope for establishing filtered permeability.
- Liaise with Cllr Roz Smith and Windmill School – wrt a trip to Waltham Forest especially for Quarry people: residents, cllrs, school head
- Greg, Lorna and Scott to start Play Streets or playing out groups in Flo Park with the aim of getting support and enthusiasm for low traffic neighbourhood scheme.

Cycling commissioner

- Develop JD for Cycling Commissioner – including agreement on title.
- Clarify how single funding or joint funding arrangements could work

Build a coalition

- Letter to all connected groups identified, in order to establish common ground.
- Produce a postcard which can be delivered by Pedal and Post
- Critical mass lead by Pedal and Post

Incident reporting

Contact Andy Ford at Fire and Rescue to ask how he would like cyclists to report close pass, near miss, and incidents that do not result in a formal police report.

Bikeability/cycle training

Establish central list of people interested in becoming a cycling instructor in Oxfordshire in order to run a central training course.

Publicise information about current arrangements for Bikeability cycle training in Oxfordshire.
