

Cyclox statement in response to cyclist death

A cyclist was killed in a collision with a car on 4 August at around 23:00:

Cyclox is saddened to hear the terrible news of the killing of a man cycling on Iffley Road. We extend our deep condolences to the victim's family and friends. One death of a person cycling is one too many. This incident underscores the vital need for safe cycling infrastructure. This junction, like other Oxford junctions, fails to provide for safe movements by people cycling. Cyclox has re-designs for the junction available that will make it safe and ask that they are given urgent consideration.

This incident highlights once more the dangers of road violence and the need to make city safe for anyone who cycles or would do so if it were made safer.
